

RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT DOLLARS

1A - Adult Services: This program provides services to job seekers that move individuals from poverty to self-sufficiency. Customers accessing these services are the disadvantaged population. In addition to meeting the income standards for eligibility, customers enrolled in 1A (Adult services) often have other barriers to employment (i.e. disabled, low educational attainment, ex-offenders, ESL, limited work experience, etc.).

Examples of services provided include: educational assessments, assistance with tuition, books, child care, transportation, job search and on-the-job training. These services are accessed at the Illinois workNet Centers and their satellites.

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Notes:

1. The numbers (in both calculations) include all enrollees in direct WIA services however, these numbers do not include those customers served only through resource room services, who are not formally enrolled.
2. Additional benefits, such as reductions in subsidies for rent, food stamps, Medicaid/Medicare, unemployment insurance, etc. are not included in the calculations.
3. Calculations are based on annual allocations received, and not dollars actually expended in a program year.
4. Allocations include PY08, PY09, PY10 and ARRA stimulus funds received in each local workforce area.
5. Return on investment is calculated by dividing the total annual allocation received by a Local Workforce Investment Area (LWIA) by the annualized wages reported in the Illinois Workforce Development System (IWDS).
